Champagne & Sparkling

De Castelnau Brut NV

£29.95

An explosion of 'tiny bubbles' with aromas and flavours of lychee, pineapple and a hint of honey – super quality.

Taittinger Brut Reserve NV

£41.95

A careful blend of twenty five different 'Crus' and aging of between 3 and 4 years go into making this delicate and elegant Champagne.

Sparkling rosé

Codorniu Pinot Noir Brut Rosé

£17.95

Unique and stylish this very posh Rosé is made exclusively from the Pinot Noir grape giving the flavour of delicious ripe summer fruits.

The White Wines

Mezzora Pinot Grigio Garganega 2008/09

£13.50*

Produced from grapes grown in the beautiful hills north of Verona, flavours of pears and summer peaches, gives a dry, fresh and stylish wine.

Boonaburra Chardonnay 2008/09

£13.50*

This full flavoured yet soft and elegant Australian white is pale straw in colour with the aroma of peaches and apricots.

Añuela Sauvignon Blanc 2009 'Casablanca Valley'

£14.50

Just a few miles from the Pacific Ocean the Casablanca Valley produces some of the very best Chilean Sauvignon. The intense aromas of fresh herb and apple, together with the flavour of exotic fruits and ripe pineapple make this smooth, lively and distinctive zesty wine.

Rosé

Grant Burge '5 Generations' Rosé 2008

£13.50*

This light, fresh wine is salmon pink and has delicate aromas of ripe raspberry and a hint of spice. It has a delicious sweetness of vibrant summer fruits, balanced acidity giving it a soft elegant finish.

And The Reds

Boonaburra Shiraz Cabernet 2008

£13.50*

Aromas of vanilla, cherry and ripe plums, this classic Australian red has the flavours of summer berries and just a hint of oak.

Añuela Merlot 2008/09 'Colchagua Valley'

£14.50⁻

From vineyards situated between the Andes and the Pacific this hand picked Merlot has the aromas of plum and fresh mulberries. It is soft and elegant with the flavours of ripe berry fruits and just a hint of vanilla from its time in barrel.

Rioja El Coto "Crianza" 2003

£16.50

A quality oak aged wine from Northern Spain's best Bodega; it is distinctive with the flavours of ripe red berries and a hint of vanilla coming from having spent some time in new oak casks.

Châteauneuf du Pape Rouge 2008

£23.95

Domaine du Vieux Lazaret

One of the Rhône's finest wines; many different grape varieties go to make this rich complex yet mellow wine and this example is from one of the top producers Monsieur Jérôme Quiot.
